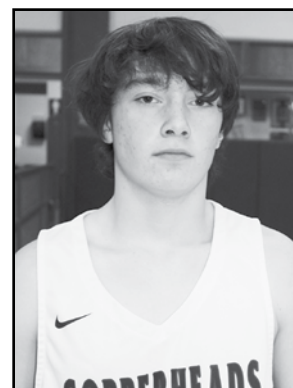

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Good Luck Copperheads!

With playoffs underway, there's high hopes for Anaconda hoops after a season full of highlights

Though the 2023-2024 regular season has wrapped up, Anaconda's hoop dreams are only just beginning as the District 6-B Basketball Tournament in Deer Lodge is now underway, with the top four teams for the boys and the girls alike to advance to Western B Divisionals in Pablo next week.

But that's getting a bit ahead of the game, as we first have a full season to review – and it's been a year full of highlights.

We'll start things off with the Lady Copperheads, who as the No. 2 seed are entering districts with a first-round bye.

The girls positively blitzed through the regular season, going 15-3 including their two Ws at the Smelter City/Prison City Tip-Off Tourney.

Led by a quartet of starting seniors in Larkin Galle, Maniyah Lunceford, Makena Patrick and Cali Pesanti and their dynamo of a junior in Meela Mitchell, and backed up by a solid set of reserves in Giana Chor, Maleah Gress, Hayden Lunceford, Quincy Saltenberger, Rain Daniels and Cate DeSanto, the Lady Copperheads currently rank eighth in Class B per Maxpreps.com.

The season started off on the right foot with the Lady Copperheads blazing past the Lady Blue Devils of Class A Corvallis, 51-33, with Lunceford towering over the competition by posting a double-double with 17 points and 12 boards. That game also saw Patrick's return

from a nearly year-long absence due to a serious knee injury she sustained early in the 2022-2023 campaign, and after easing back into the lineup she's returned to pre-injury form.

Another big story for the girls was the 11-game winning streak they rattled off to start the season, practically all of them blowouts, with double-digit wins over Charlo, Stillwater, Drummond, Thompson Falls, Florence, Philipsburg, Butte Central, Arlee and Deer Lodge. Next up after all that were the Lady Falcons with a chance for revenge, but Anaconda escaped Florence with a two-point win.

Then it happened. That improbable buzzer-beater of a loss when St. Ignatius

put up a prayer practically from half court to hand Anaconda their first loss of the season. Then it was two more in the L column, literally, with Loyola-Sacred Heart breaking out the brooms for the regular-season sweep of the Lady Copperheads.

Yet rather than let that get to them, Anaconda came roaring back with a home-and-home drubbing of Darby, a domination of Deer Lodge at home on Senior Night, and another shellacking of the Scarlets to wrap things up before playoff time.

But the story of the season so far for the girls has to be the emergence of Mitchell as Anaconda's leading scoring threat, particularly in the paint with quick drives to the basket. The 11th grader

has turned her game up to 12 – or more like to 20 or more, as she's cracked the 20-point mark at least 10 times this season by our count. She hung the Lady Copperheads' first 30-burger on a team (31 against St. Ignatius) since Patrick last did so in December of 2022, and just missed two more 30-point outings by a single digit.

With just the three losses to two teams, the Lady Copperheads are poised to make a run to divisionals and beyond. Their first postseason game is Friday afternoon against the winner of Florence vs. Arlee, and with a win they'll play for the district title on Saturday.

The third-seeded Copperhead boys' playoff run started Thursday night against Darby, and while

this publication went to press before the result of that game was known we can say that the two times these teams have faced each other this season it was Anaconda all the way. With a win, the 'Heads would have their chance at revenge against the Warriors of Arlee, who handed them a pair of losses this season.

A win in that revenge game would propel Anaconda into the district championship on Saturday, and punch their ticket to divisionals, while a loss would pit them against the loser of Deer Lodge vs. Florence in a loser-out game. Fortunately for the 'Heads they've defeated both those teams twice this season in dominant fashion, and a win in that

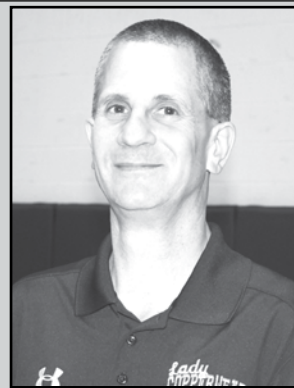

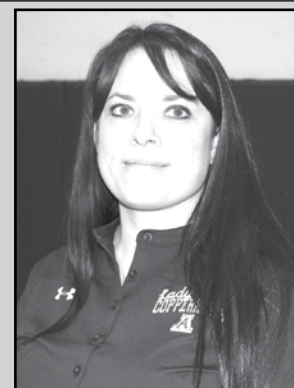

game would send them to the third-place game and on to divisionals.

At 12-6 on the season so far, including their wins at the Tip-Off Tourney over Stillwater and Harrison, the Copperheads are currently ranked 11th in Class B per Maxpreps.com.

The boys have fared extremely well against three of their five district opponents, Darby, Deer Lodge and Florence, posting double-digit wins (and often then some) over each, while Arlee has given them some trouble and Loyola is looking like the team to beat in the entire state. Anaconda's other Ws came against Drummond,

Thompson Falls, Philipsburg and St. Ignatius, while their remaining Ls were against former Class A rivals Corvallis and Butte Central.

Led by a bevy of seniors – Tytan Cook, Tanner Cromwell, Wade Dahood, Billy Farmer, Cory Galle, Riley Kriskovich, Cael Mikalatos, fan favorite Aidan Tuss and, of course, 6-6 star River Hurley – and backed up by capable crew of sophomores in Brody Galle, Shane Schalk, Travis Dye and Treyton Patrick, the Copperheads certainly have depth going for them.

While Hurley has often been Anaconda's leading scorer this season, and has reached or surpassed

the 20-point mark at least a half a dozen times, this is a deep team full of contributors who've demonstrated they can put the ball in the basket – and keep the opposing team from doing the same.

And while the nine seniors for the boys and five more for the girls will surely be missed once the season concludes, there remains a talented bunch of up-and-comers – including a massive group of freshmen and sophomores on the boys' side – who no doubt will be ready to step in once it's their time to shine. But for now, it's playoff time. And all we can say to that is, Go Copperheads!

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Copperhead wrestling's successful 2023-24 season capped by a state HWT championship

That's a wrap on the 2023-2024 Copperhead wrestling season, and it's hard to imagine it going much better than it did from start to finish.

And what a finish, with senior Aidan Miller bringing home Anaconda's first-ever state heavyweight wrestling championship. Miller made history for the 'Heads by going undefeated at the Class B/C State Wrestling Tournament in Billings last weekend to cap an already impressive run in which he won first place at divisionals and had only lost four matches the entire season heading into the tourney.

And there would be no more in the loss column, but plenty more in the win side of the scorebook as he went 4-0 at state, including three wins by pin and a 10-0 major decision in his final match as a Copperhead to take home the hardware. Miller concluded his senior season with a 36-4 record and his high school career with 110 Ws.

While Miller's historic run into the record books has to be the biggest story of the wrestling season – and the biggest in Copperhead sports so far since the boys' golf team won state back in May – there were plenty more highlights from '23-'24.

One is the youth movement that's afoot in the Copperhead wrestling room, a fact that's well represented by Owen Pesanti making All-State as a freshman by taking

sixth place in his class at state, and that's after a first-place finish at the CMR Holiday Classic. fellow freshman Roddy Wyant and sophomores Remington Bussard and Zach "Taco" Blodnick also made it to state. Indeed 10 of the 12 Copperheads who made it to state are part of that youth movement, so the future is looking quite bright for 'Heads wrestling.

The future is now for the Copperhead girls' wrestling team, who sent an impressive seven wrestlers to state this year – and came home with a sixth-place finish amongst all Class B/C schools. The girls were led by senior Ryleigh Warner

who, like Miller, eclipsed the 100-career-win mark in her final season with the Copperheads, and put together several impressive performances this year at some big meets including fifth place at the CMR Classic and third place at divisionals.

While Warner's high school wrestling career also has wrapped up, there will be plenty more to watch for the girls in the future as she was the girls' wrestling program's only senior. Junior Kendra Redd, in her first year wrestling, won the girls' 138-lb. class at divisionals and is one of three juniors along with Ady and Camy Hoiland, plus freshmen

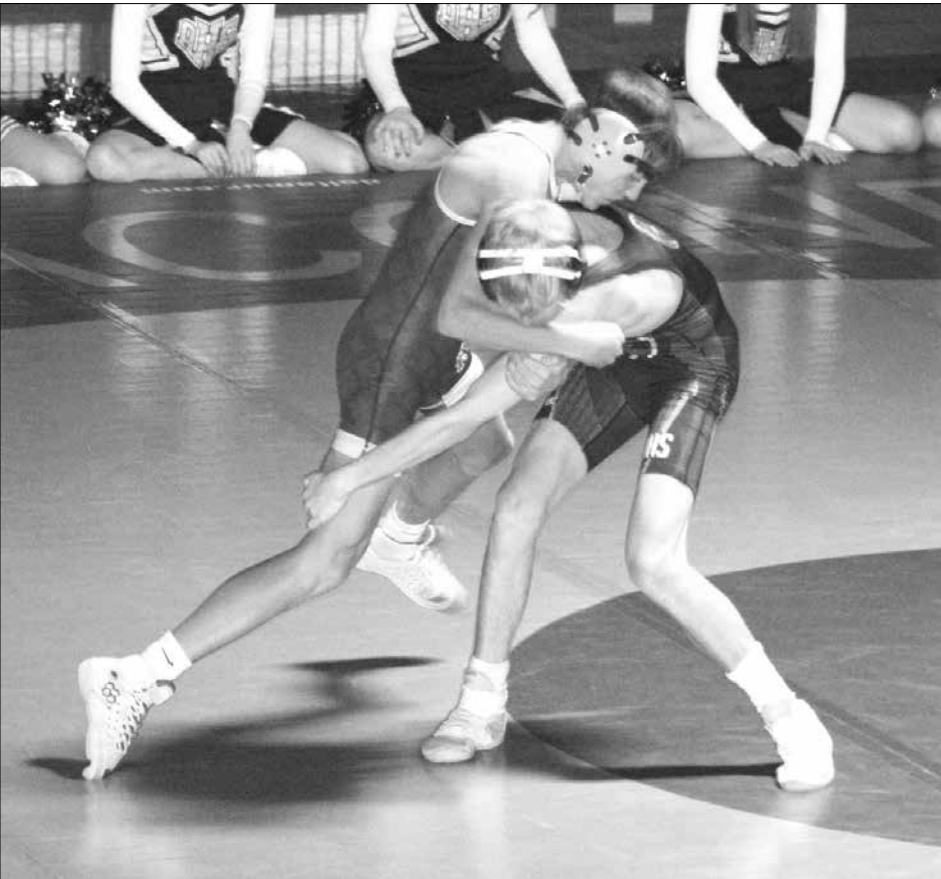
and sophomores Tabitha Cheetham-Bjornemo, Jaidyn Holdaway and Rachael Rogers, who made it to state.

While state was certainly the culmination of a successful wrestling season, it wasn't the only highlight. One of our favorite scenes was under the lights at the Snake Pit on Senior Night, when Anaconda hosted Townsend's Broadwater High School for the annual Copper Shamrock duals. The Copperheads made it four in a row over the Bulldogs, doing so with an utter domination of the scorecard with a 60-18 victory. While most of the matches were won

by forfeit as Townsend did not have wrestlers for many of the weight classes, it just showed how the Copperhead wrestling program is thriving under Head Coach Joe Casey and assistant coaches Ryan Pesanti, Riley Forcella and Tyler Forcella.

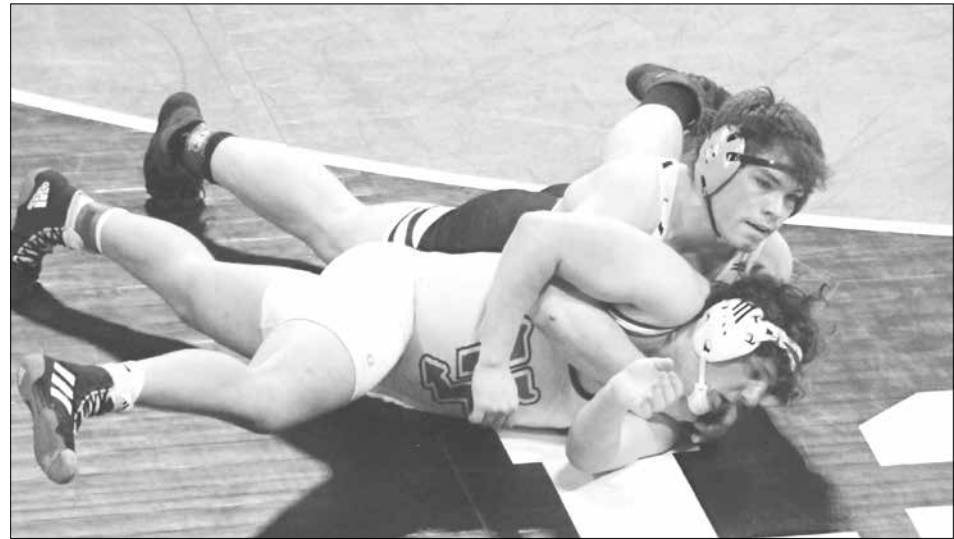
"There's a lot of youth on this team. It's sad to see the seniors go, but all in all they've been a great bunch," Casey said in a previous interview. "It's a really young team and it's going to be exciting to see how they develop. It's really fun coaching them, they gave it their all."

They certainly did. Congratulations to all our Copperhead wrestlers on a successful season!
